In Matthew 19:14 we hear, "Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs." That is the cost of having children as part of our community. If you have a hard time focusing because the children are playing, go and join them. You will never go wrong if you try to become more like a child. Most likely, Jesus would love it.
